She was named a 2020 National YoungArts Winner, and has received several other awards, including MTNA Pennsylvania State Winner (2015), Honorable Mention (2016, 2019), Alternate (2017 & 2018), first prize in Division 3 (Ages 14-18) at the 2018 Steinway Piano Competition, and second prize at the New Orleans Piano Institute's Solo Competition (2015). She was appointed as the Harmony For Peace Foundation's Junior Peace & Music Ambassador for 2018.

She has performed as a soloist with the Southeastern Pennsylvania Symphony Orchestra, the Warminster Symphony Orchestra, the Ambler Symphony, the Old York Road Symphony, and the New Orleans Civic Symphony. She was one of five semi-finalists in the Junior Division of the 2019 Philadelphia Orchestra Albert M. Greenfield Student Competition.

Aside from piano, Emma also plays the violin. She is currently a first violinist with the Philadelphia Youth Orchestra, and was a first violinist in the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) 2020 All-National Symphony Orchestra.
